TO: AGREEMENT

DEPARTMENT FISH & WILDLIFE RESOURCES

THIS AGREEMENT made the 29<sup>th</sup> day of January, 1962 between the Nicholas County Development Corporation, hereinafter referred to as the Corporation, and the Commonwealth of Kentucky, Department of Fish and Wildlife Resources, hereinafter referred to as the Department,

Witnesseth, that

Whereas, the Corporation are sponsoring agents for the construction of a lake to be used as recreational and fish propagation waters,

Whereas, the Department is desirous of obtaining fish and wildlife rights with respect to this completed project has offered \$10,000 for these rights, said sum to be expanded for payment of clearing timber and underbrush from this project.

Whereas, the Corporation has appointed representatives to negotiate and supervise this construction and enter into contract with the Department for sale of public fish and wildlife rights.

Now therefore, the Department agreed to pay to the Corporation the sum of ten thousand (\$10,000.00) dollars to be used for the purpose of clearing timber and underbrush from this project. This project is to be constructed in Nicholas County, three (3) miles northwest from the city of Carlisle. The corporation agrees that the lake will be open to the public at all times and subject to all customary FISHING REGULATIONS GOVERNING FISHING IN Kentucky waters and further agree that it will be bound by all customary boating regulations governing boating on public waters in this State set forth by the Division of Boating and the Department of Fish and Wildlife Resources.

The Corporation agrees not to hold the Commonwealth or the Department or other agency thereof responsible for any damages that might arise from flooding or any land owned or claimed by the Department.
